



WEEKLY UPDATE

June 5, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As we approach summer and Maryland is starting to reopen slowly, we want you to know that the staff at Restore Health Rehabilitation Center continues to work hard to prevent further spread of COVID-19 in our facility.

As of today, 10 residents and 5 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. All of our have resolved and all staff members have returned back to work. We tested one resident today due to an elevated temperature and the resident is being isolated until we receive the results of the test. The National Guard continues to reach out to us weekly as well and we appreciate their efforts in assisting us to prevent the spread of this virus.

Our Activities Department offers daily activities to include hand massages for each resident while donning appropriate PPE, individual spiritual readings, walk way music where residents are in their door way dancing to music, and scavenger hunts for items in each resident's room.

In addition to the increased safety precautions we have previously reported, our facility also has a dedicated COVID unit for our COVID positive residents. Once the resident has completed 14 days of isolation on the COVID unit and has improved symptoms, we have created a transition (step-down) unit for 14 more days of quarantine until returning back to the non-COVID units. There are dedicated staff members working on the COVID unit that do not provide care in any other part of the facility to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. We are committed to continue seeing the number of positive cases in our facility decrease and we will work with our federal, state and local health officials to protect our residents and staff to stop further spread of this virus in our facility.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
